Court Square Group Recognized as Winner of 2011 Microsoft Life Sciences Innovation Awards

CORRONA, the Consortium of Rheumatology Researchers of North America, Inc. was founded in 2000 by leading rheumatologists whose mission is to advance rheumatology research and improve the quality of rheumatology patient care. CORRONA needed a more robust solution to collect data and easily modify their questionnaires for this ongoing longitudinal patient database. Previously using an antiquated system, CORRONA knew it needed to more flexible and dynamic platform and collection system to accommodate the rapid changes in science and informational demands.

The solution developed by Court Square Group relied on Sharepoint to provide an extensible and flexible rules-based security model. The application, based on Infopath, feeds patient data into a SQLServer database. Capabilities have been built to automatically email subscribers based on adverse event trends. CORRONAbase is the foundation for a Physician's Quality module, a "Treat to Target" clinical Trial, and a multi-language application to collect data in ten different countries.

CORRONA has now been able to collect and data mine more than 76,000 patient years of records for over 35,000 patients for the past 10 years. This is the largest source of



Rheumatoid Arthritis information in the world and has become the foundation for other clinical trials and international studies. Most major pharmaceutical companies that have any products specifically for Rheumatoid Arthritis now subscribe to the CORRONA system.

Jim Cavan, CORRONA's Chief Operating Officer comments; "The increasing scientific, data quality, regulatory and reporting demands from our subscribers required we seek a better solution. As we found none in the off the shelf market we worked to develop one. The SharePoint environment allows us to continually improve our functionality while maintaining a virtual company structure."

"Court Square is extremely proud of this award as it reflects our commitment to the ideals that CORRONA has in furthering research into Rheumatoid Arthritis. Our work in the Life Science arena, and particularly with Corrona, illustrates our commitment to using technology to help change the way that medicine is practiced.
