IT Portfolio Management and Planning

IT project proposals get approved for all kinds of reasons. But too often, they are for the wrong reasons. The result is one or more of the following scenarios that result in poor return on investment.

Too many projects are given highest priority

The project is unlikely to add value to the business strategy or is not well understood

The project is approved because of the squeaky wheel sponsoring it

The progress of multiple projects is not visible and many projects may be redundant
